- The one-time Grant amount of \$1,000 will be applied directly to the student's San Francisco Theological Seminary business account by September 1, 2019.
- A Grant recipient who withdraws from the program before completing the first term forfeits the Grant amount on a prorate basis consistent with the SFTS tuition refund and financial aid policy.
